PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Entries must observe all applicable rules and regulations or be barred from the parade. The Stayton 4th of July Committee and its Parade Committee reserve the right to remove from the parade either prior to assembly, at assembly or at any time during the parade, any entrant not conforming to these rules and regulations or any entrant refusing to follow the instructions of police or parade officials. All entries must be approved by the Parade Committee before entering the line of march.

Entries may be historical, humorous or modern in design, so long as they are in good taste. Those planning entries should remember that a large part of the audience will be children.

Entrants must observe established parade rules, regulations and entry criteria:

1. The entry application must be filled in completely and must contain a full description of the proposed entry, including the name of the persons responsible for the entry, the name of the individual responsible during the parade for the entry and the name of the person who will represent the organization or group in a personal appearance before the Parade Committee, if such appearance is deemed necessary.
2. The parade parking & setup will be at Regis parking lot - Parade will line up and start on Regis Street. **The route will be down Regis Street to First Ave., south on First Ave., then west on Washington to Gardener, north on Gardener to Regis.** The length of the Parade route is approx. 1 mile. Because of road construction, the route may be changed.
3. No vehicles will be allowed to park in the formation area.
4. **The information area will be open at 1:30pm on the day of the parade.**
5. **All parade participants must be in position no later than 3:00pm so judging may be completed before the parade. Ribbons will be given to the winners before the parade begins.**
6. The parade will be disbanded on Regis Street..
7. All floats and decorated cars must carry out a 4th of July theme. No undecorated cars, trucks, motorcycles or bicycles, except car clubs, will be allowed.
8. **Materials and candy may not be thrown from an entry under any circumstances. This is a safety requirement that will be enforced. A person or persons walking alongside the entry may pass out approved materials or candy.**
9. All motorized entries must have liability insurance coverage in force, be properly licensed vehicles, and be driven by a licensed driver.
10. All entries must obey police directions, instructions from the control units and parade personnel, and the Oregon Revised Statutes concerning the operation of a motor vehicle. No erratic driving or squealing of tires will be tolerated. **The police will strictly enforce this rule.**
11. Use of pressure water hoses, water dispensing devices or high density sound-making devices will not be permitted.
12. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on or in any entry vehicles and no consumption of alcohol by parade participants will be allowed prior to or during the parade.
13. Entries **MUST** stay within 50 feet of the entry directly in front of them, but no closer than 30 feet for parade spacing.
14. **All participants and ANY part of the entry must be able to travel at least 10 miles per hour or it will be asked to leave the parade due to parade spacing.**
15. It is the responsibility of the sponsor to furnish all necessary materials for the entry.
16. Marching units and all personnel participating in the parade as a group must be identified as such, either by distinctive costumes, uniforms, insignia or clothing. All marching units shall march as a group. Exceptions may be granted upon written request describing the participating unit.
17. Entries advocating, opposing or depiction of any political or social issues are subject to approval by the Parade Committee. The Committee's decision is final.
18. All entries will be subject to approval of the Parade Committee. Any entry failing to comply with these specifications or deviating in a significant manner from the description supplies on the entry form will be considered automatically disqualified from entry in the parade.
19. Maximum float length of 35 feet. Oversized trucks or other commercial vehicles exempted.
20. Floats are judged on originality, decorations and use of the parade theme during the parade.

You need to be in line by 3pm to be judged.

During extremely hot weather, you may bring your vehicle down beginning at 1pm and have your participants join you at 3pm.
